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SHOW CAUSE NOTICE

Mr. Vicky Dayal Chhabria, aged 28 years (DOB: 15.01.1992), residing at Barrack No. 306-A, Room No. 11, Nr. Jhulelal Mandir, Ulhasnagar, Thane (hereinafter referred to as the 'passenger'), holding an Indian Passport No.R4117791 had arrived at Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport, Ahmedabad from Abudabhi by Etihad Flight No. EY 252 on 13.02.2020. The passenger was carrying one grey colour trolley bag as hand bag. The said passenger had opted for green channel. On the basis of suspicious movement, the passenger was intercepted at the exit of the green channel for personal search and examination of his baggage.

2. Whereas, The AIU officer intercepted one passenger named Mr. Vicky Dayal Chhabria, aged 28 years, when he was trying to move out from the Green Channel with his Boarding pass. The AIU officer asked him if he had any dutiable goods to declare, to which the passenger denied of having any such goods. Therefore, the Customs Officer told the said passenger that they would be conducting his personal search and detailed examination of his baggage in the presence of panchas. Thereafter, the passenger was asked to pass through the Door Frame Metal Detector (DFMD) located near the Green Channel after removing all the metallic substances such as mobile, wallet, belt etc. The passenger readily removed the metallic substances from his body such as mobile, purse, belt etc and kept them on a table; and when he passed through the DFMD, no beep sound was heard. On this, the AIU Officers politely asked the passenger whether he was still having any metallic objects left in his clothes or hidden in his body. However the passenger denied again. The passenger was then asked to pass through the DFMD once again and on his passing, no beep sound of DFMD was heard. Thereafter, on the basis of suspicion, the passenger was carrying some metallic item concealed in his body, his check-in bags consisting of one green trolley bag and blue trolley bag alongwith a black back pack brought as hand baggage, was screened in the baggage screening machine but nothing objectionable was found. The passenger was then taken back to the AIU office and there he was interrogated by the AIU officers. On further and repeated interrogation, the passenger finally confessed that he was carrying gold paste in four capsules and removed four black capsules from his rectum and showed it to the AIU officers.
